There was discussion about Semi-truck and trailer parking. This also led to overall parking of trailers or any sort on city streets.

It was decided to recommend to the Council that all licensed trailers not be allowed to park on city streets. There was also discussion' on asking the public to let the City know if a trailer will be parked on the street for home repairs, moving in or out, etc.

The recommendation for the East End Semi parking is as follows ..

1. Have Gary do a survey of the area to determine how semis may be able to be accommodated in the area.
2. That a cement strip should be laid down for trailer parking at the city's expense.
3. That the Mayor checks with the Insurance carrier about any added coverage that may be needed.
4. That the Mayor check with the Lawyer about any legal issues that may need to be addressed.
5. That each driver of a Semi that wishes to use the facility purchase a \$100.00 permit to park there each year. This will help to defray the cost of initial outlay and up keep. This would also allow us to develop a data base of those using the facility in case of an emergency.
