

New Sharon City Council Meeting

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Monday, March 3, 2008 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Ed Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Dianna Klinker, Lisa Munn, Zack Pickard and Larry Applegate. City employees in attendance were Kevin Lamberson and Diane Brand. Others in attendance were Tim Fuller, Brad Korell, Melissa Korell and Michael Schaffer.

Pickard made a motion to approve the consent agenda, Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Applegate made a motion to approve Resolution #030308A to levy for property & liability insurance in the 2008-2009 budget. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Munn made a motion to open the public hearing at 7:05 p.m. to vacate the east/west alley between lots 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Block 4 of Devore's Addition and the east/west alley between lots 4 and 5 of Block 5 of Winder's Addition to Tim Fuller at \$2 per linear foot.

Pickard made a motion to vacate the alleys to Tim Fuller. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to close the public hearing at 7:10 p.m. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Applegate made a motion to approve Resolution #030308B approving the final plat of North Ridge Addition Plat 4. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Applegate made a motion to approve a building permit for Brad & Danielle Latcham for a new home to be constructed in the North Ridge Addition of New Sharon. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

The Water/Sewer/Street report was given by Davis. The river is over the road @ the river pump house. The sewer is taking on a lot of water due to the melting snow and ice. The weather is taking a toll on the streets.

The Police Report was given by Lamberson.

Klinker arrived at 7:40 p.m.

The Cemetery report was given by Applegate. He presented the council with a bid from Hoven's Lawn Care. Applegate made a motion to hire Hoven's Lawn Care again this year. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

The Clerk's Report was given by Brand. The retirement party for Junior Fisher went very well. Approximately 77 people stopped by to wish Junior well.

The Mayor reminded the Council of the upcoming public hearing for the 2008-2009 Budget Estimate. It is scheduled for March 6, 2008 @ 7:05 p.m.
