

New Sharon City Council Meeting
Wednesday, August 20, 2008
7:00 p.m., City Hall

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Wednesday, August 20, 2008 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro-Tem Larry Applegate presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Larry Applegate, Lisa Munn and Zack Pickard. Dianna Klinker and Mayor Davis were absent. City Employees in attendance were Kevin Lamberson and Diane Brand.

Pickard made a motion to approve the consent agenda, Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

After some discussion about the application from Scooters Pub & Grub for a Class C Liquor License, Pickard made a motion to wait until they could gather some more information concerning the business and when it would be opening. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Hawkins, Inc. installed a new chlorine pump at the in town pump house today. This will allow the city to use liquid chlorine instead of granules. City workers have been patching S. Mulberry Street and had to stop because the air compressor quit working. Applegate has repaired it and they can now finish the patching.

The Police Report was given by Chief Lamberson. There was discussion regarding installing a window in the police station and fixing the door. The council suggests hiring someone to get it done before winter.

The Cemetery report was given by Applegate. There have been four stones repaired at the cemetery. The south drive near the storage shed is washing out; Applegate wants Gary Strobel to take a look at it. Terri Burch will be painting the storage shed.

The Clerk's report was given by Brand. The ambulance disclaimer was read and is as follows: The New Sharon Fire Department is a provisional advanced ambulance service, equipped with a defibrillating device. Its provisional status means that because it is a volunteer department there can be no guarantee that someone qualified to use the defibrillator will be on every emergency call.

There was discussion regarding an inquiry into purchasing a lot that the City owns that is located east of the City shop. The council does not wish to sell it at this time.

The City received a bill from the courthouse for taxes on the property at 707 S. Main Street. Casey's has offered to pay a portion of those taxes. The council agreed to pay \$371.00 and Casey's will pay \$1113.00.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Pro-Tem Applegate adjourned the meeting at 7:40 p.m.
