

**New Sharon City Council Meeting**  
**Tuesday, September 2, 2008**  
**7:00 p.m., City Hall**

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Tuesday, September 2, 2008 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Ed Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Dianna Klinker, Lisa Munn and Zack Pickard. Larry Applegate was absent. Others in attendance were Diane Brand, Ralph Ihde, Jim Hargis & Scott Farrington.

Munn made a motion to add Item #6 Josh Tremmel – building permit – under Public Comments & Requests and Item #1 Class C Liquor License for Scooter's Pub & Grub – under New & Unfinished Business to the agenda. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve the consent agenda, Klinker seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Klinker made a motion to approve Resolution #090208 – Street Finance Report Fiscal Year '08. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Klinker made a motion to approve a building permit for Vance Alexander to erect a 24 x 54 shop behind his house. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Ward made a motion to allow Dwight Randels to pour a concrete slab beside his house to park his camper on. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve a grant from the NSREDF Fund in the amount of \$1274.00 to Define Styling for improvements to her building. Klinker seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There was discussion at this time regarding purchasing the remaining old school square lots back from Scott Simmons. Ralph Ihde will talk to Simmons and have him get abstracts up to date; he will give him the check at that time. They will transfer the lots to the NSREDF and then back to the City. There was also discussion regarding the new Early Childhood Education Center.

After lengthy discussion regarding Scott & Sharon Farrington's request for a low interest loan to help with equipment costs for Scooter's Pub & Grub; Munn made a motion to approve Resolution #090208A – authorizing the loan in the amount of \$30,000 and that a contract be drawn up by the City Attorney. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve the Class C Liquor License for Scooter's Pub & Grub. Klinker seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Munn made a motion to approve a building permit for Josh Tremmel to erect a deck on his house. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

The Water/Sewer/Street report was given by Mayor Davis. Mulberry Street has been patched. Kluesner Construction should be here next week to begin working on the streets. One of the dump trucks has a noise in the transmission. Gary will bet an estimate on repairs.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Davis adjourned the meeting at 8:50 p.m.
