

**New Sharon City Council Meeting
Wednesday, October 15, 2008
7:00 p.m., City Hall**

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Wednesday, October 15, 2008 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Ed Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Larry Applegate, Dianna Klinker and Lisa Munn. Zack Pickard was absent. Others in attendance were Diane Brand, Kevin Lamberson, Kim Kiefer, Scott Farrington and Sharon Farrington.

Klinker made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Klinker made a motion to approve Resolution No. 101508 Sale of 1986 International Dump Truck. Ward seconded. Roll call vote: All ayes.

The council received a request from Connie Molenburg regarding her last water bill. Connie's water softener was leaking. She used 15,450 cubic feet of water on her last bill. Munn made a motion to allow Molenburg to make payments of \$50/month on the past due bill and waive finance charges on the past due amount only. In addition, Molenburg is to pay all current charges by the due date. If the current bill becomes past due she will be required to pay finance charges on that amount. Applegate seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Kim Kiefer appeared before the council regarding her sewer at 202 E. Maple Street. She claims that the sewer is backed up. She gave the council the name of the plumber that has been working on it. Mayor Davis will call him and find out what is wrong. Kiefer also had complaints about Scooter's Pub & Grub. She claims that there are fights in the parking lot and cars driving through her yard. Scott & Sharon Farrington told the council that there have not been any fights that they are aware of. They will be adding a deck for smokers. There will no longer be any alcohol going out the front door.

The Water Report was given by Mayor Davis. VanWyk has flushed hydrants and found one hydrant on W. Market that needs repaired.

The Cemetery Report was given by Applegate. Twin Hills Nursery & Landscaping planted 12 new trees. There are some stones that have been overturned. Applegate is having them repaired.

The Clerk's report was given by Brand. The end-of-year financial report is complete. Brand will mail it to the accountant for review. Brand will have three years of service in on November 3rd. She will then apply for her Certified Municipal Clerk's Certification.

There have been some complaints about a shed that has been built in the back yard at 507 S. Mulberry Street. The owner will be putting up a privacy fence and he will put siding on it to make it look better.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Davis adjourned the meeting at 8:15 p.m.
