The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Wednesday, January 21, 2009 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Edwin Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Dianna Klinker, and Larry Applegate. Zack Pickard and Lisa Munn were absent. Others in attendance were Diane Brand and Kevin Lamberson.

Klinker made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Applegate made a motion to approve Resolution No. 012109 vacating the alley to Vance Alexander and setting the public hearing date for February 2, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. Klinker seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

The water pump went out of Gary Strobel's pickup. It has been repaired.

The Police Report was given by Kevin Lamberson

The Cemetery report was given by Applegate. The City will be taking care of the snow at the cemetery now and Larry Applegate will help when he can.

The Clerk's report was given by Brand. The Ambulance disclaimer was read and is as follows: The New Sharon Fire Department is a provisional advanced ambulance service, equipped with a defibrillating device. It's provisional status means that because it is a volunteer department there can be no guarantee that someone qualified to use the defibrillator will be on every emergency call.

The City will be receiving a rebate from Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities for insurance in the amount of \$4,786.

Applegate made a motion to approve a request from the Fire Department to pay \$540 towards safety vests for the fire station and city workers. Klinker seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There being no further business to discuss, Davis adjourned the meeting at 7:40 p.m.
