

**New Sharon City Council Meeting
Wednesday, December 16, 2009
7:00 p.m., City Hall**

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Wednesday, December 16, 2009 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Edwin Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Lisa Munn and Larry Applegate. Zack Pickard was absent. Employees in attendance were Diane Brand and Kevin Lamberson.

Munn made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There were no public comments and requests.

Mayor Davis gave the water and sewer reports. The hanging furnace at the river pump house went out. The renovations to the pump house included in the water improvement project, call for an electric furnace. Mayor Davis will ask Jack Pope if it is possible to go ahead and upgrade this furnace now. New tires have been installed on the end loader.

Lamberson gave the police report. He helped again this year with the Lighted Christmas Parade in Oskaloosa.

Applegate gave the Cemetery Report. He is still getting bids for lawn mowers.

Brand gave the Clerk's Report. The ambulance disclaimer was read and is as follows: The New Sharon Fire Department is a provisional advanced ambulance service, equipped with a defibrillating device. Its provisional status means that because it is a volunteer department there can be no guarantee that someone qualified to use the defibrillator will be on every emergency call. The City received the ISO report back for the fire hydrants and it was a very good report.

Munn made a motion to set a public hearing date for January 4, 2010 at 7:00 pm to hold the first reading of the amendments to Ordinance Chapter 69 and Chapter 70 pertaining to Truck Parking and Parking Fines. Applegate seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There being no further business to discuss, Davis adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.
