The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Monday, February 1, 2010 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro-Tem Larry Applegate presiding. Munn made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Munn made a motion at 7:02 pm to open the public hearing for the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the ordinance amendments. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Ward made a motion to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance Chapters 69 & 70 and waive the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes. The ordinances will be effective upon publication.
