

New Sharon City Council Meeting
Wednesday, February 17, 2010
7:00 p.m., City Hall

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Wednesday, February 17, 2010 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Edwin Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Lisa Munn, Zack Pickard and Jeff Foster. Larry Applegate was absent. Employees in attendance were Diane Brand and Kevin Lamberson. Jack Pope attended.

Pickard made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion at 7:03 pm to open the public hearing to make available to the public the contents of an environmental information document regarding the City's project to make improvements to the water supply system to increase reliability in order to safely and reliably operate for at least the next 20 years. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Jack Pope with Garden and Associates was on hand to present the Environmental Information Document. This project will not cause a significant impact on the environment. There was no one from the public in attendance.

Pickard made a motion to close the public hearing at 7:15 pm. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Mayor Davis gave the water, sewer and street reports. Everything is running smoothly at the water plant and the lagoon. City workers have been busy trying to keep up with snow removal. The lagoon is closed to the public for yard waste at this time due to ice.

Lamberson gave the police report. Handicapped parking spaces were discussed. Vertical signs need to be placed in front of each handicapped parking space. It is not sufficient to paint the curb. Brand will call the IA DOT to find out if they have regulations that are more specific.

There was no Cemetery Report.

Brand gave the clerks report. Stephen Memorial Animal Shelter responded to two neglect calls and picked up three strays during the month of January.

Munn made a motion to set a date for March 1, 2010 at 7pm for the 2010-2011 Budget Estimate Hearing and March 17, 2010 at 7pm for the 2009-2010 Budget Amendment Hearing. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There being no further business to discuss, Davis adjourned the meeting at 8:35 pm.
