

**New Sharon City Council Meeting**  
**Monday, April 5, 2010**  
**7:00 p.m., City Hall**

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Monday, April 5, 2010 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Edwin Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Lisa Munn, Jeff Foster and Zack Pickard. Larry Applegate was absent. Employees in attendance were Diane Brand, Kevin Lamberson, Gary Strobel and Matt VanWyk. Others in attendance were Don Frank, Grady Lewis, Lee Munson and Bob Donohoe.

After adding a building permit application for David Wells to the agenda Pickard made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion at 7:01 pm to open the public hearing for a building permit for Brandon Murphy and Alison Mitchell. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There were no comments from the public. Pickard made a motion to approve the building permit. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Ward made a motion to close the public hearing at 7:02 pm. Foster seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve a building permit application for Don Frank and set April 21, 2010 @ 7pm as the public hearing date. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve a building permit application for Donna Fenton and set April 21, 2010 @ 7pm as the date for the public hearing. Foster seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve a building permit application for Jim Reed and set April 21, 2010 @ 7pm as the date for the public hearing. Foster seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Munn made a motion to approve a building permit application for David Wells and set April 21, 2010 @ 7pm as the date for the public hearing. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to approve a liquor license renewal for East Market Grocery. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Munn, Foster and Pickard. Nays: Ward. Motion carried.

Foster made a motion to allow Grady Lewis to run electricity on city right of way. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

VanWyk gave the water report. The Environmental Study has been completed and the new well site has been approved. The curb stop at 301 W. Market needs to be replaced. The clerk will send them a letter giving them 90 days from the date of the notice to have it replaced.

Strobel gave the sewer and street reports. As soon as Fox and Haworth can start digging, the sewer extension project on W. Cherry Street can begin. The City needs to place more rock around the lagoon roads. The Mayor requested that the street sweeper be used at least twice per month.

Lamberson gave the police report.

There was no cemetery report.

Brand gave the clerks report. There were three stray cats picked up by Stephen Memorial Animal Shelter in March. The council approved a request to hold Spring Clean-Up every year on the last Monday and Tuesday of April.

Pickard made a motion to accept a bid from L.L. Pelling for \$53,048.30 for seal coating some streets in town. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Lee Munson attended to discuss the fire works and the trailer to be placed at the lagoon. The trailer will be coming sometime this week. After checking with the spring festival committee, June 11, 2010 will be the date of the fireworks display.

Munn made a motion to accept a bid from Terpstra Masonry for \$16,115 for repairs to the City Hall building. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Pickard made a motion to accept a bid from Simmons Construction for \$12,900 for concrete work at the intersection of Cherry Street and S. Elm and a handicapped approach on S. Mulberry. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

The council received a request from Vance Alexander to quit claim deed a portion of an alley to him. The Mayor will consult with the city attorney on how to proceed.

Munn made a motion to proceed with trying to get possession of the property located at 408 W. Maple Street. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

There was discussion regarding the city parking area for semis located at the city shop area. Strobel will inquire about millings from the state.

There being no further business to discuss, Davis adjourned the meeting at 8:50 pm.
