

**New Sharon City Council Meeting
Wednesday, March 16, 2011
7:00 p.m., City Hall**

The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Wednesday, March 16, 2011 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Jeff Foster, Lisa Munn and Zack Pickard. Larry Applegate was absent. Employees in attendance were Kevin Lamberson and Diane Brand. Pickard made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All eyes.

Munn made a motion to open the public hearing for the building permit application for Jeff Foster at 7:01 p.m. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Pickard, Munn, Ward. Abstentions: Foster

Pickard made a motion to approve the building permit. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Pickard, Munn, Ward. Abstentions: Foster

Pickard made a motion to close the public hearing at 7:03 p.m. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Munn made a motion to approve a building permit application for Denise Peacock and set a date for a public hearing for April 4, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

John & Angela Livezey appeared before the council to request a grant for either \$25,539 or \$30,289 for an addition of an automatic bay at the carwash. After some discussion, Munn made a motion to discuss and make a decision at a special meeting held on March 23, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. Pickard seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

Bruce & Rhonda Wallace appeared before the council to discuss purchasing the southeast corner lot at the Old School Square and put a manufactured home on it. Munn made a motion to discuss this at the special meeting to be held on March 23, 2011 at 5:30 p.m.

Davis gave the water, sewer and street report. The work at the river pump house is running on schedule. Drilling of the new well should commence in approximately two weeks. The flow meter at the sewer plant has been sent to Eastech for repairs.

Lamberson gave the police report.

Brand gave the clerk's report. Brand will contact American Cleaning Services to clean the carpet at City Hall. Brand asked about the route for the Jace Race and the council would like to discuss it at the next meeting.

The council discussed donating to the school for new bleachers. Mayor Davis will talk to Randy Moffit.

There was discussion regarding the USDA money. The council would like Steve Harkema to attend the next council meeting to discuss this further.
