

**New Sharon City Council Special Meeting
Wednesday, March 23, 2011
5:30 p.m., City Hall**

The New Sharon City Council met in special session at City Hall, Wednesday, March 23, 2011 @ 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Davis presiding. Council members present were Kenneth Ward, Jeff Foster, Lisa Munn and Zack Pickard. Larry Applegate was absent. City Clerk, Diane Brand also attended. Others in attendance were John & Angela Livezey, Bruce Wallace and Ken Lacey.

Pickard made a motion to approve the agenda. Munn seconded. Roll Call Vote: All eyes.

John & Angela Livezey attended to ask for a grant to add an automatic carwash to their current carwash. After some discussion, Pickard made a motion to approve a grant for \$10,000 and a loan for \$20,000. The grant is to be paid after the project is complete. The loan will be interest free and no payments for the first year then 5% interest for 5 years. Foster seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.

After some discussion regarding the ordinance pertaining to manufactured homes being set on a foundation, Mayor Davis told Bruce Wallace he needed a couple days to do more research.

Munn made a motion to approve Resolution No. 032311 Defining the Relationship with New Sharon Recreation and Economic Development Foundation. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.
