The Small Business Relief Grant is supported by anonymous donors. <u>Eligibility Requirements:</u> Applicants must own a small business in Mahaska County and must use the funds to offset losses due to COVID-19. In addition, priority will be given to those businesses that did NOT receive funds from the State of Iowa or Federal sources. Any non-profit or for profit business is eligible to apply. Chamber membership is NOT required.

<u>Funding Amounts:</u> Awards range from \$500 - \$5,000 until all funds are expended. Awards are based on selected criteria as listed in the application.

<u>Distribution</u>: Distribution of the awards will take place in June 2020.
